

Mountain summer farming community responses to strong external stressors

- **Background/framework:**
International research project "Mitigation and Adaptation in Cultural Heritage Landscapes: Lessons from Transhumant Pastoral Systems for Managing Novel Climate Risks"

- **Objective:**
Document former adaptive community actions of mountain summer farmers in Valdres, triggered by extreme weather events / climate change, and possibly other societal or political shifts
- **Method:**
1) Key interviews with, e.g., local historians, 2) Document analysis: Climate records, Archives of local and national media, and of the Valdres Museum at Fagernes
- Language: Interviews and documents in Norwegian, thesis preferably in English
